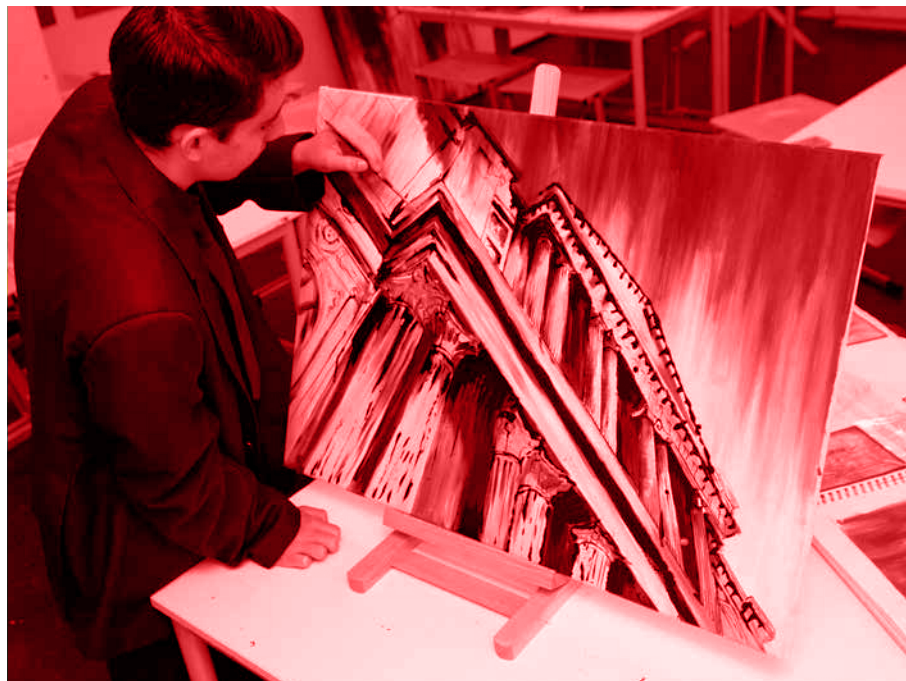

Futures Gateway programme

The curriculum is strengthened by our 'Futures Gateway career programme'. The aim of this unique programme is to inspire students and guide them into Further Education, Higher Level Apprenticeships or employment in order fully achieve their ambitions, aspirations, hopes and dreams.

We have invaluable partnerships with over 60 employers from the business sector and over 30 educational providers which extends the successful programme outside the Academy providing students with opportunities to work in local industry whilst still in School.

Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)

Our most able students have the opportunity to complete the EPQ. This is equivalent to an AS qualification and is looked upon favourably by all university admissions teams.

The qualification gives students the opportunity to develop critical, reflective, problem-solving and independent learning skills through the planning, research and evaluation of a self-selected project. It is a compulsory element of the Post-16 programme of study for any student in the college who wishes to continue their studies in the area of Medicine, Dentistry or Veterinary Science. 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Higher Education and Careers

All Saints Sixth Form College aims to be the perfect stepping stone from school to university or employment.

Here at All Saints, we believe careers education, information, advice and guidance (CEIAG) are vital components to a young person's learning and development.

We want all our students to achieve their true potential, not just in school, but in the wider community and beyond when they eventually complete their time with us.

To support our students as much as possible with their career decision making, we have designed a careers and employability strategy that offers a quality, bespoke careers education plan for all. The Sixth Form has celebrated record results at A Level. As well as beating the national average for A*grades, 50% of students achieved A*, A, and B grades with 100% pass rate at BTEC. 100% of students were accepted at their preferred university with 28% of students securing places at prestigious Russell Group universities.

Work Experience

In addition to one week's work experience which is compulsory for all year 12 students, there will be an opportunity for some students to attend a work placement one day per week as a requirement of their programme of study.

Scholars Programme

The Scholars programme is an aspirational programme which aims to support our most able students as they progress through the academy and into the College.

Most able students are mentored throughout their academy life and supported by a bespoke Oxbridge programme. This provides students the opportunity visit and study at Russell Group Universities including Oxford and Liverpool University. Prestigious scholars' events take place regularly providing students from all years with opportunities to access pathways to law, young medics programme and to meet highly successful visiting business professionals.
