DAY	WORD	DEFINITION
MONDAY	EXCELLENCE (<i>noun</i>)	The quality of being outstanding or extremely good.
TUESDAY	TREMENDOUS (<i>adjective</i>)	Very great in amount, scale, or intensity.
WEDNESDAY	ENDURANCE (<i>noun</i>)	The ability to endure an unpleasant or difficult process or situation without giving way.
THURSDAY	INITIATIVE (<i>noun</i>)	The ability to assess and initiate things independently.
FRIDAY	CRITICASTER (<i>noun</i>)	A minor or inferior critic.
